Little did I know when God led me to begin Encouragement Inc. that we would have orphanages in Africa along with Youth Shelters rescuing abandoned boy and girls in Kenya.

Recently I was told by our Director of the Boys Youth Shelter in Kakamega that many young girls were living on the streets fending for themselves. Being the father of two daughters myself, I could not imagine the horrors of such circumstances these girls must face on a daily basis. I was told we could rent a house in Kakamega and pay the utilities for around \$200 per month. Having no extra funds to help, I felt in my heart, that I would ask you, my friends, to donate towards providing for rent & utilities.

This Girl's Shelter will provide love, acceptance, forgiveness and a meal along with a safe place to sleep. At this time we have received enough funds for 9 months. I am happy to report to you that we have sent the first month's rent and a house has been rented. FOUND BY POLICE: These three boys were abandoned at the local police station and were severely traumatized. They had been kept in a prison cell (standard procedure for abandoned children) and when we picked them up they were dehydrated, suffering malnutrition, and full of chiggers. After just a few days at Encouragement they are getting treatment, eating, drinking and SMILING! Praise the Lord! They may only be with us temporarily, but usually long-term.
