Wow! Another year come and gone! God has been so good to us, in spite of the difficulties of the Covid. Our ministry has been blessed by God as He has led many tender-hearted people to come along side us in our Vision to rescue orphans in Kenya and Uganda. Having our missionary, Katlyn Pollock, stationed in Webuye, Kenya is an answer to many years of patience and perseverance knowing that in God’s timing He was preparing the right person for such a time as this. Just prior to Katlyn heading to Kenya my wife Debbie and I had the opportunity to host her for a few days in our home. During that visit I will never forget Katlyn sharing with me how that at age twelve she sensed God, *“laying it on her heart to be a missionary in Africa.”* Her love for God combined with her Leadership Skills and Work Ethic is exactly what we needed at the Encouragement Children’s Home in Kenya. Two of which are little girls, ages 6 and 9, who were living on the harsh streets in the large and dangerous city of Kakamega. Even now my heart is touched as I think of the trauma these little girls have already experienced. We need help to feed, clothe and house these girls ASAP. I am trusting God to provide for these and more as we begin a “Rescue Shelter for Girls” in Kakamega. We can rent a house for around \$200 per month that can be used as a temporary shelter. If we can get 12 people to donate for one month’s rent we can cover the first year of providing this temporary girls shelter.
